


New word - **GLEBE**

- **Glebe** is a term from the English manorial system referring to an area of land within an ecclesiastical parish used to support a parish priest.
- The land may be owned by the church, or its profits may be reserved to the church.
- Glebe is land (including the parsonage house/rectory and grounds) assigned to support the parish priest.
