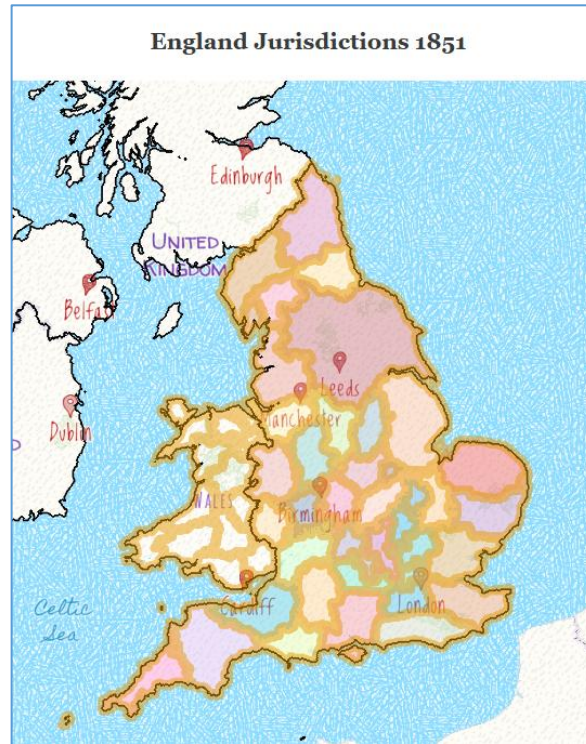

- This opens the brand-new **England Jurisdictions 1851** webpage, which just went live on May 23 and is currently in Beta testing. The previous version of this maps page has been suspended pending full implementation of the new version.
